Dear Title I School Parent or Guardian,

No Child Left Behind legislation requires all teachers to be highly qualified.

Your child currently attends a school that receives funds from the Title I, Part A program. Title I, Part A is a federal supplemental program designed to help children reach high academic standards. In receiving funds from this program the district has a requirement to inform you, as a parent of a child attending a Title I school, of information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher. A highly qualified teacher is defined as a teacher that meets Michigan's qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level or subject area in which the teacher is providing instruction. At this time all of the teachers responsible for instructing your child maintain a highly qualified status.

However, as a parent or guardian you have the right to request the professional qualifications of your child's teacher or paraprofessional. If you wish to do so, please put this request in writing and submit it to the building principal. You will receive a written response within ten school days from the receipt of your request.

The intent of this letter is to continue open and transparent communication regarding the qualifications of the WSC Academy Teaching Staff. WSC Academy thanks you for your continued support.
